The scholarship funding is to support the participation of individuals or community-based organisations who would not otherwise be able to attend this kind of conference, e.g. those for whom financial support for this kind of professional development is not available.

ANZEA scholarships

A scholarship provides for full Conference registration from Tuesday 23 March 10am to Thursday 25 March 3.30pm.

How do you apply?

The application form is below. Your application must be accompanied by a letter of support from someone, we want to know why this conference would be beneficial for you to attend. This could be:

- A letter or email signed by the Head of Department or similar at the institution you are attending.
- A letter or email of endorsement from someone who knows you well. This might be a community leader or someone of high standing in your community (e.g. kuia, kaumatua, Church Minister, a senior representative from an organisation you are part of, Justice of the Peace, etc.).
- A letter or email of endorsement from a Manager (or similar).

- The ANZEA Conference Committee will receive, review and allocate scholarships.
- **Applications close 5pm Wednesday 17th March 2021.**
- Unsuccessful applicants will be offered the opportunity to register at a discounted rate.
